SUP ATX Carbon Fiber Adjustable Paddle \$185

This paddle offers everything other carbon fiber stand up paddles offer in 95% of stand up paddle applications for one half to one third the price of competitor carbon fiber paddles.

There may be a few standard paddles, not adjustable = would need to be cut to size. These are \$145.



XM NEW Power Clip Coil SUP Ankle Leash \$35

With the popularity of stand-up paddling and surfing, surfers and paddlers have requested a leash that best meets their needs. You may select the coil (recommended for flat water paddling) or straight (recommended for surfing) urethane cord, ankle or calf straps, but customers have liked the security of having the "Power Clip" advantage for fast detachment if necessary!

XM SUP Day Bag 12' \$130 (Backordered – due August 13th)

XM Board Bags feature heavy duty padded shoulder straps and super strong YKK zippers. They are made of high density foam to protect your boards and the outer silver reflective fabric helps to protect your board from sun damage.

Each bag has extra pockets with and a hanger, features that make these more a “hybrid” bag, light but strong, for pennies more than other plain “sleeve-type” bags.



XM Soft Rack Car-topping System \$35

The soft rack system fits most any car with easily adjustable straps and strong nylon webbing. The rack system also uses a new high-tech cam buckle to secure any board. The top and bottom of the pad has a new non-slip/non-abrasive rubber allowing for the ultimate care of your board and your car. Just position the pads, pull the strap through the car, secure it and slip it over the boards.... tighten and off you go. It's that easy and that secure.



Downunder Rack Pads and Straps \$35 (in-stock)

Two pads and straps that can be used for any equipment you're car-topping– kayaks or boards. Straps can go through car or around existing racks.

C4 Waterman Security Locking system \$97

Soft rack, secures and locks surfboards, kayaks, and other gear to racks. Works with a single key.

Kit for cars w/o racks retails for \$199

Works like traditional soft racks, but with one pair of Steel Core straps running through the car and over the roof. The Steel Core surf carrier attaches to those roof straps.

Bluestorm Waist Lifejacket \$119 (in stock)

Inflate orally or by pulling the cord to activate the hydrogen cartridge. Some people like the comfort of not 'wearing' a lifejacket, yet recognize the importance of having one with them – should the wind pick up, or you find yourself separated from your board. Whilst these lifejackets are more comfortable than a traditional lifejacket, they don't allow for unforeseen situations such as accidents that might leave you unconscious and having no flotation device. These factors should be considered when considering a lifejacket.
